WHAT IS A CHW?

A **"Community Health Worker"** is an individual who contributes to improved health outcomes in the community. CHW's promote health within the community in which they reside and/or share ethnicity, language, socioeconomic status, and life experiences with the community members that the individual serves. A community health worker proactively:

- Serves as a liaison between communities and health care agencies
- Provides guidance and social assistance to community residents
- Enhances community residents' ability to effectively communicate with health care providers
- Provides culturally and linguistically appropriate health education
- Advocates for individual and community health
- Provides referral and follow-up services or otherwise coordinating care
- Identifies and helps enroll eligible individuals in federal, state, and local private or nonprofit health and human services programs
- Can work in a community-based, inpatient or other healthcare setting

The Eastcentral PA Area Health Education Centers (ECPA AHEC) offers a 100-hour training program designed to provide the core competencies needed for work in community-based and inpatient settings. The training also provides comprehensive information about accessing healthcare and other social/community resources which are specific to the area where the training takes place.

We are an **Accredited Community Health Worker Training Program** through the **Pennsylvania Certification Board** for those seeking training to become a **Certified Community Health Worker (CCHW)**.
